

Substance Use Prevention Risk and Protective Factors

Common Risk Factors

- √ Genetics
- ✓ Peer Influence
- ✓ A lack of supervision
- ✓ A lack of community resources/opportunity
- √ Unclear expectations regarding use/behaviors
- √ Inaccurate perception of peer use and parental concern
- √ Sense of entitlement
- √ Alienation/marginalization

Common Protective Factors

- ✓ Delayed use/Abstinence
- √ Consistent community message
- ✓ Be part of the village/See something-say something
- ✓ Access barriers
- ✓ Opportunities to contribute in the community
- ✓ Family, schools and community programs should work in tandem
- ✓ Set high standards/expectation regarding substance use
- ✓ Exist in all aspects of your young person's life
